

INSTRUCTIONS MANUAL FOR **ALUMINIUM POT & KETTLE**

Before use:

Before initial use, the pot must be washed thoroughly using hot water and washing-up liquid. Fill the pot with water. Bring it to boil and then pour out the water. Now the pot is ready for use.

Usage:

With advantage the pot can be hung from a suspension-mounting, making it easy to turn the heat up or down by either hoisting up or lowering down the pot. Alternatively the pot can be placed directly in the fire or on a pot-mounting. If you warm up an empty pot using intense heat, the pot may be damaged. Superheating an empty pot (above 300° Celsius) should be avoided.

Special Precautions:

Aluminium corrodes when exposed to acidic or alkaline liquids as well as to potentially salty liquids. Therefore you are advised to avoid storage of such foods in the pot before and after preparing the food on the fire*.

Preparing such foods in the aluminium pot can, under certain circumstances, result in an unpleasant undertaste. Sour foods are: tomatoes – cabbage – rhubarbs and a variety of soft fruits such as plums.

Cleaning:

Clean the pot using a washing-up liquid.

Maintenance:

The pot requires no maintenance except cleaning.
